The Old City, honoured for millennia, will captivate your heart.

The journey continues in Bethlehem, where we will visit the birthplace of Jesus and the Cave of Jerome.

We then travel to Jericho, taking in the views from the Mount of Temptation before visiting the place where Jesus was baptised.

All of these are recorded in the eyewitness accounts of the gospel writers for us to read. But they truly come to life today when we read them as we stand and pray at the places they describe.



Tour Itinerary

Day 1:

Wednesday 9th March: Departure

Begin your pilgrimage as we depart Luton and fly to Tel Aviv, where our guide greets us for the journey ahead. Settle into our Jerusalem hotel for dinner and rest as anticipation builds for the days to come.

Day 2:

Thursday 10th March: Jerusalem / The Old City

Walk in the footsteps of Jesus through the Old City—from St. Peter in Gallicantu and the Upper Room to the Pools of Bethesda and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. End the day in Bethlehem after a meaningful visit to Gethsemane and rich reflections with Rev. Richard James.

Day 3:

Friday 11th March: Bethlehem & Hebron

Visit the ancient Tombs of Abraham and Sarah in Hebron, a deeply spiritual encounter at one of the most sacred biblical sites. Return to Bethlehem for lunch at Bible College, hear the testimony of local ministry, and wind down with an evening speaker.

Day 4:

Saturday 12th March: A Day of Remembrance in Jerusalem

Experience the calm and hope of the Garden Tomb before visiting Yad Vashem and the British War Graves to reflect on history and sacrifice. Return to Bethlehem for a peaceful evening of collective reflection with Rev. Richard James.

Day 5:

Sunday 13th March: Worship & the Old City Quarters

Join worship in Jerusalem before the Western Wall, if possible the Temple Mount, and the historic quarters of the city. Continue to our Bethlehem hotel for dinner and evening reflection with Richard James.

Tour Itinerary

Day 6:

Monday 14th March: Jericho, Baptismal Site & The Dead Sea

Discover the world's oldest city—Jericho—before standing at the Baptismal Site of Jesus along the Jordan River. After lunch at Qumran, unwind with the unforgettable optional experience of floating in the Dead Sea. Return to our hotel in Bethlehem.

Day 7:

Tuesday 15th March: Bethlehem's Sacred Sites

Continue your journey through Bethlehem with visits to Shepherds Fields, the Church of the Nativity, and the Cave of St. Jerome. The evening concludes over dinner with a guest speaker who shares insight and inspiration.

Day 8:

Wednesday 16th March: Nazareth & the North

Drive through the fields of Armageddon on the way to Nazareth to explore the Basilica of the Annunciation and the Synagogue where Jesus taught. Overnight in Tiberius as the story of Jesus' early life comes vividly alive.

Day 9:

Saturday 17th November: Galilee: The Ministry of Jesus

Visit Capernaum, the home of St. Peter, and stand on the Mount of Beatitudes overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Continue to Tabgha, where Jesus multiplied the loaves and fish, before an evening reflection with fellow pilgrims. Sleep in Tiberius.

Day 10:

Sunday 18th March: Magdala & Farewell to the Galilee

Walk through Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene, and enjoy a memorable boat trip on the Sea of Galilee. Transfer to the airport for the journey home, returning to Luton where a private coach returns us to Norfolk with hearts full and memories made.

How to Book

You can book this tour by completing the booking form and submitting it together with your initial deposit of £300 per person.

Deposit Structure

Due to current airline pricing conditions, bookings are confirmed using a two-stage deposit system:

Deposit 1 – Place Deposit (£300 per person)

- Payable at the time of booking
- Secures your place on the tour
- Fully refundable until flights are ticketed (subject to administration fees)

Deposit 2 – Flight Commitment Payment (dependent on airline)

- Payable within 14 days of booking (or earlier if flight prices require)
- This payment allows us to purchase and ticket your flights
- Once flights are ticketed, this payment becomes non-refundable, except where airline rules permit refunds less any penalties

Paying the Balance

A final invoice will be issued approximately 10–12 weeks before departure, and the remaining balance must be paid no later than 10 weeks before departure, unless otherwise stated.

Further travel information, including final flight details, accommodation information, and meeting arrangements, will be sent to you closer to departure.

Airline schedules and seat allocations are controlled by the airlines and may be subject to change.

Normally, tickets are issued electronically and confirmed prior to departure. Final travel documents will be provided before travel.

Fitness and Mobility

People of all ages are welcome; however, a reasonable level of fitness is required. Some sites involve uneven ground, steps, and walking over historic terrain. If you have mobility concerns, please discuss these with us before booking.

Passports, Visas, and Vaccinations

Travellers are responsible for ensuring they hold a valid passport suitable for international travel. Passports must generally be valid for at least six months after the date of return.

Visa requirements depend on nationality. British passport holders now require the ETA IL Electronic Visa prior to departure. Please contact info@twelvepilgrims.co.uk if you're unsure.

No specific vaccinations are required at the time of publication, but you may wish to consult your GP or travel health clinic for personal advice.
