Day 1 – Arrival in Israel

Flight to Tel Aviv

Depart from **London Luton** on our flight to Tel Aviv.

On arrival, meet our local guide and transfer to our hotel in **Jerusalem**.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 2 – Jerusalem: Old City & Mount Zion

- Davidson Centre – Jerusalem in the time of Jesus
- Southern Wall Excavations
- Temple Mount & Pool of Bethesda
- Walk the Via Dolorosa
- Church of the Holy Sepulchre
- Tower of David
- Western (Wailing) Wall

Afternoon:

- Mount Zion
- David's Tomb
- St Peter in Gallicantu
- The Upper Room
- Garden Tomb

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 3 – Bethlehem & Mount of Olives

- Yad Vashem – Holocaust Memorial
- Bethlehem: Church of the Nativity
- Shepherds' Fields
- Beit Sahour

Mount of Olives:

- Chapel of the Ascension
- Panoramic view of Jerusalem
- Church of Paternoster
- Palm Sunday Road
- Dominus Flevit
- Garden of Gethsemane

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 4 – Jerusalem & Genesis Land

- Pool of Siloam
- Optional walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel (pay locally)
- Israel Museum
 - Model of the Second Temple
 - Shrine of the Book (Dead Sea Scrolls)
- Bethany
- Genesis Land – including a camel ride

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.



Day 5 – Masada, Dead Sea & Qumran

- Masada – Herod's hilltop fortress (cable car ascent/descent)
- Float in the Dead Sea
- Qumran – discovery site of the Dead Sea Scrolls

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 6 – Galilee

Travel via Jericho, visiting the ruins, then continue to Tiberias.

- Mount of Beatitudes
- Tabgha – Loaves & Fishes
- Church of the Primacy
- Capernaum – hometown of Jesus
- Boat trip on the Sea of Galilee

Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 7 – Nazareth & Cana

- Cana of Galilee – first miracle
- Nazareth:
 - Synagogue
 - Nazareth Village (extended visit)

Return to Tiberias via Megiddo and Mount Tabor (possible site of the Transfiguration).

Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 8 – Caesarea Philippi

- Bethsaida
- Caesarea Philippi – Peter's confession of Christ
- Walk through the Banias Nature Reserve
- View the spring feeding the Jordan River

Free time in Tiberias.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 9 – Return Home

Depart Galilee for the airport, visiting Caesarea Maritima, including the amphitheatre and aqueduct.

Return flight to London Luton.

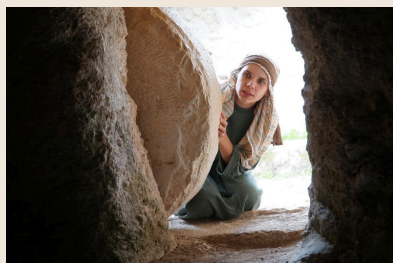

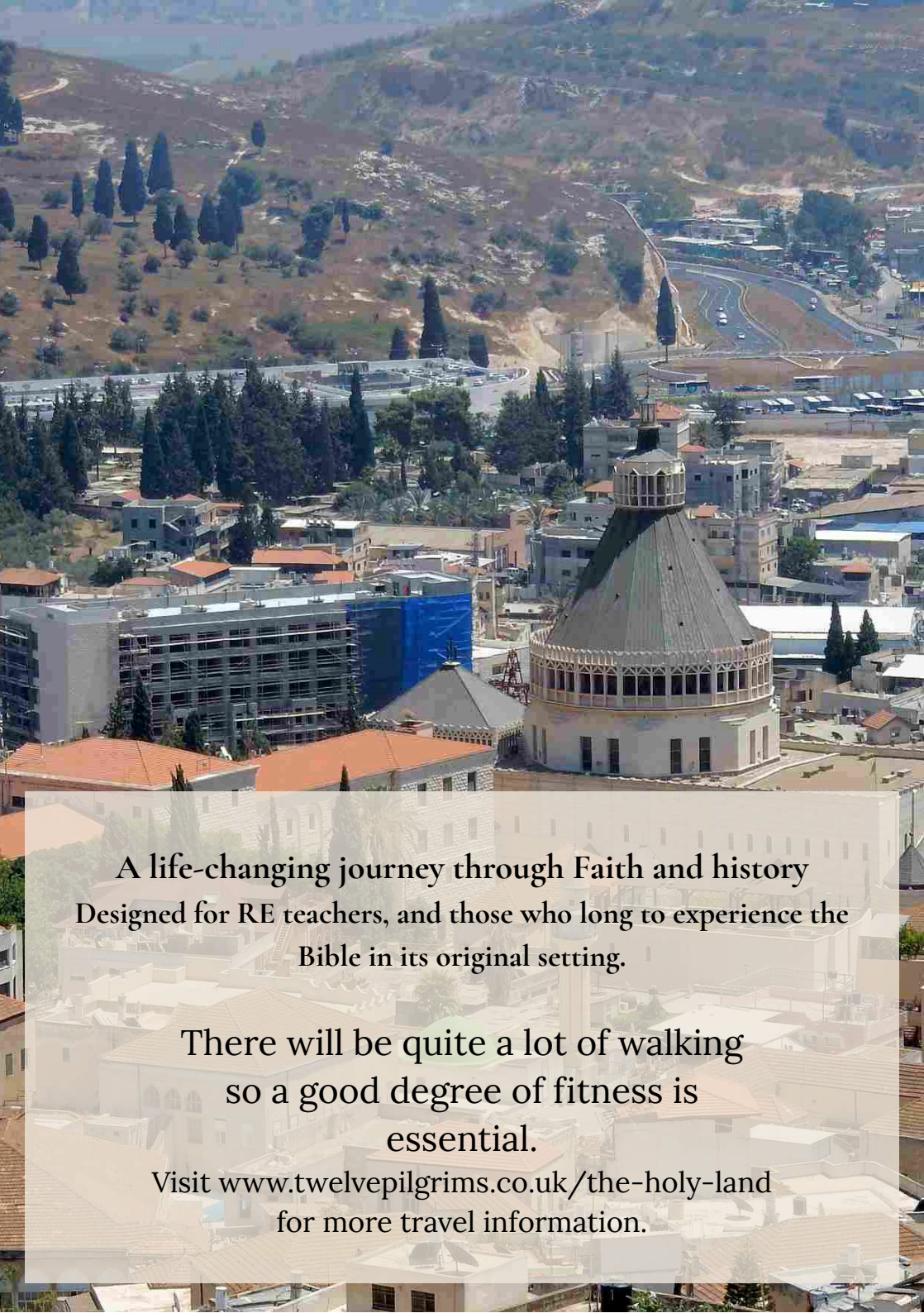
